

Situation 7  
**Loading an Ordered Car**  
Non-Perishable Freight

Prototype Equivalent

When an ordered car has been delivered to a customer, the customer loads his outgoing shipment into the car and advises the Freight Agent that the car is ready to be picked up.

S&P Implementation

Wayfreight arrives at an industry and finds a car card containing a Car Order in the **Hold** Box.

The Car Order identifies this industry as the consignee ("Shipper").

The Car Order is removed from the car card and placed in the Car Orders Box.

The Freight Waybill for the corresponding car type from the Pending Shipments Box is put in the car card.

The car card/waybill is placed in the Hold Box

When all work at this industry is completed the Freight Agent moves any cards in the Hold Box to the Pickup Box and any cards in the Setout Box to the Hold Box

The train is released to move to the next industry.

Situation ID Triggers

Car card containing a Car Order in the **Hold** Box

8 card boxes identifying this as a "ship and receive" industry

Freight Waybill in the Pending Shipments Box
